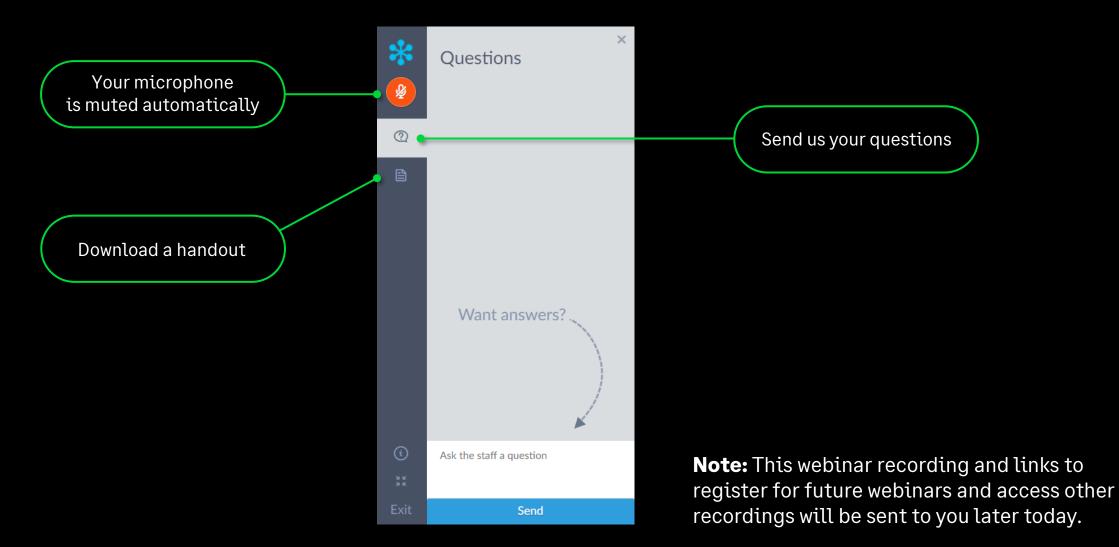

Expressions

Introduction

- An expression tells Report Designer what information to include in a report.
- When the report is generated, each expression is calculated to produce a value
- An expression is a formula that can include:
 - numbers
 - text
 - variables (data fields)
 - operators
 - functions

Expressions

BODMAS

An acronym to help you remember the order of mathematical operations.

- **B** Brackets
- O Orders (powers/indices or roots)
- **D** Division
- **M** Multiply
- **A** Addition
- **S** Subtraction

BIDMAS

Essentially the same: Brackets, Indices, Division/Multiplication, Addition/Subtraction.

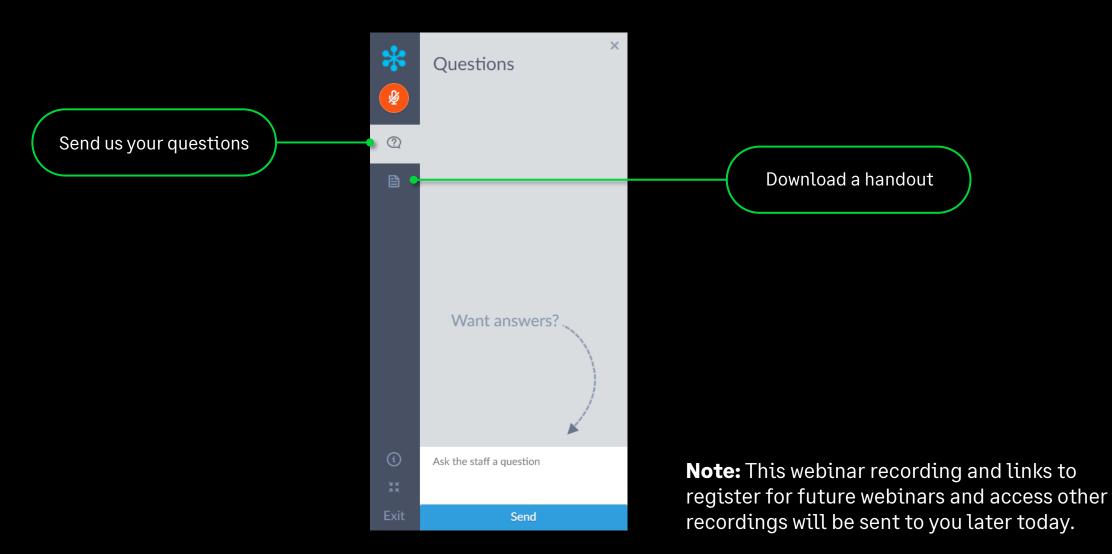

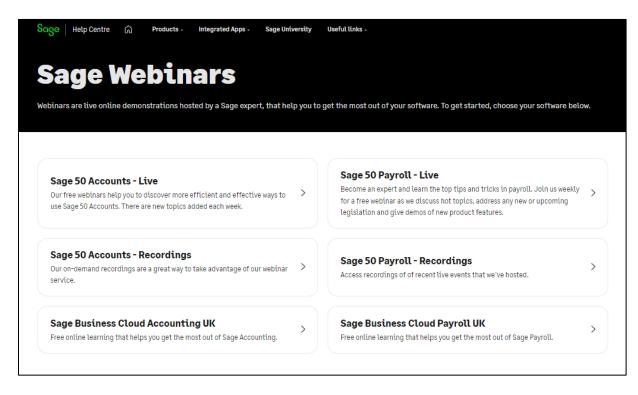
