

Why clear stock transactions and delete records?

- It's an **optional** task
- Recommendation Up to 20,000 product and service records.
 - Check in Help > About > Records
- Removing older transactions and records you no longer need in your live company helps to ensure your software runs efficiently
 - Processing may be quicker
 - Reporting faster
 - Check data takes less time
 - Backups are smaller



Manually deleting records

- Record types
 - Stock Item
 - Non-Stock
 - Service Item (Professional only)
- Products and services > select your records > Delete

Tips for selecting records

- List selection style
- Filter
- Swap / Clear




Clear stock transactions

• Tools > Period End > Clear Stock > All or Selected > enter required date > Clear stock

Note: You'll be prompted to back up as part of this process

Reporting considerations

Retrospective Product Valuation






Delete stock records

Tools > Period End > Delete Stock > Start scan > identifies all records that can be deleted

Note: You'll be prompted to back up as part of this process.

Manually select - or - Swap/Clear




Why can't I delete a record?

- 1. Items still in stock Stock Items only
- 2. Stock code(s) still have transactions Stock Items only

Sage 50 Accounts Professional only

- 3. Stock code(s) are possible sub-components
 - BOM component has a link level
 - Run the Reverse Product Explosion Report
- 4. Stock code(s) have allocations Record > Allocated
- 5. Stock code(s) are on order Record > On-Order




